b. Construct a line, d , that is parallel to line p and contains point D .

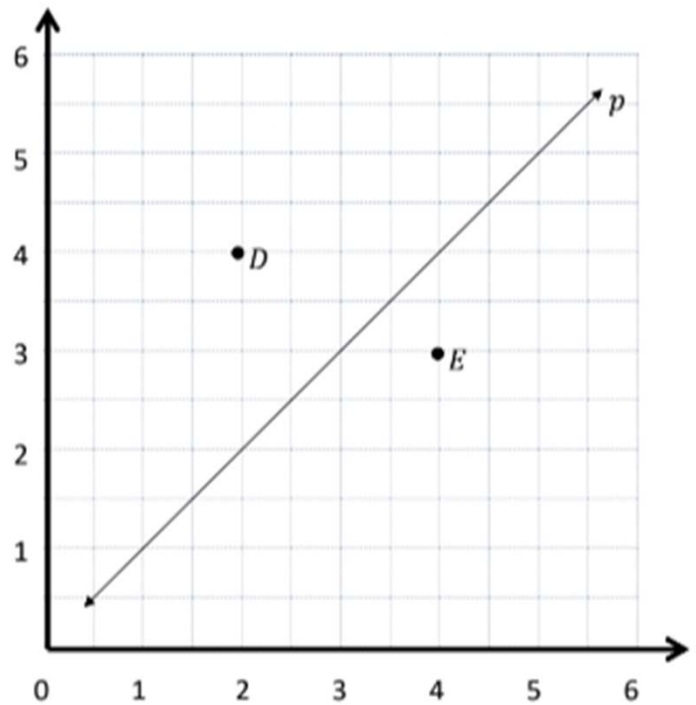
c. Name 3 coordinate pairs on line d .

d. Identify a rule to describe line d .

e. Construct a line, e , that is parallel to line p and contains point E .

f. Name 3 points on line e .

g. Identify a rule to describe line e .



h. Compare and contrast lines d and e in terms of their relationship to line p .

1. Use the coordinate plane below to complete the following tasks.

a. Line p represents the rule, x and y are equal.

b. Construct a line, d , that is parallel to line p and contains point D .

c. Name 3 coordinates pairs on line d .

$(1\frac{1}{2}, 3\frac{1}{2}), (2\frac{1}{2}, 4\frac{1}{2}), (3, 5)$

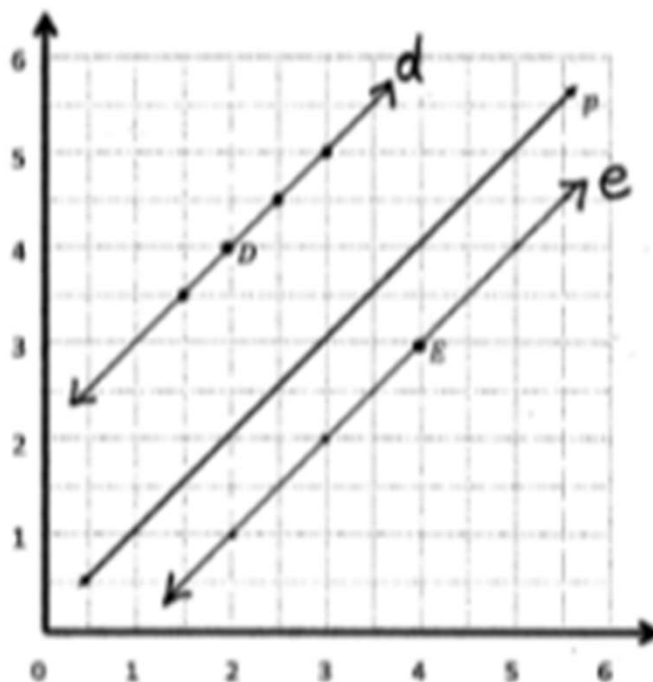
d. Identify a rule to describe line d .

Y is 2 more than X .

e. Construct a line, e , that is parallel to line p and contains point E .

f. Name 3 points on line e .

$(2, 1), (3, 2), (5, 4)$



g. Identify a rule to describe line e .

Y is 1 less than X .

h. Compare and contrast lines d and e in terms of their relationship to line p .

Line d has y -coordinates that are 3 greater than line e 's. Otherwise, they are both parallel to line p .
